Matilda The Musical, winner of multiple Tony and Olivier awards, will be produced May 7-24, 2020, by CATCO is Kids and CCT at the Shedd Theatre, 549 Franklin Ave. There are five adult actors and 14 youth actors in the production.

Inspired by the genius of Roald Dahl, *Matilda The Musical* is the captivating masterpiece from the Royal Shakespeare Company that revels in the anarchy of childhood, the power of imagination and the story of a young girl who dreams of a better life. The tale of Matilda, a special child with an extraordinary imagination, has delighted audiences young and old since its premiere on London's West End in 2011 and on Broadway in 2013.
